

Tensions escalate along LoC

Tensions escalated along the Line of Control (LoC) in Jammu & Kashmir after Indian Army reportedly killed at least three Pakistani soldiers in strong retaliatory action on Thursday.

Earlier, Pakistan Army had initiated ceasefire violation even before 73rd Independence Day celebrations went underway in border areas of Poonch. Fresh exchange of fire in Uri sector was also reported in Kashmir valley.

Defence PRO in Jammu, Lt-Col Devender Anand claimed, "Pakistan Army initiated ceasefire violation by firing of small arms and mortars on Krishna Ghati sector of Poonch around 7.00 a.m. The



exchange of firing continued till 5.30 pm, he added. In response, Indian Army befittingly retaliated to the ceasefire violation by the Pakistani troops," he said.

Pakistan Army spokesperson Major General Asif Ghafoor had earlier accused the Indian Army of "increasing firing" along the Line of Control to "divert attention

from precarious situation in Jammu & Kashmir".

Releasing pictures of three Pakistani soldiers Asif Ghafoor tweeted, "three Pakistani soldiers, killed in the ceasefire violations, have been identified as Naik Tanveer, Sepoy Ramazan and Lance Naik Taimoor".

Meanwhile, the Indian Army has also denied the

Pakistan Army's claims that five Indian soldiers died in the ceasefire violations along the Line of Control (LoC).

Meanwhile, Northern Army Commander Lt Gen Ranbir Singh accompanied by the Chinari Corps Commander Lt Gen KJS Dhillon, on Thursday visited Kupwara on the occasion of the 73rd Independence Day.

He interacted with the troops and was briefed about the recent counter infiltration operations.

He was appreciative of the sharp vigil and alertness along the Line of Control.

The Army Commander lauded the high morale of the troops and exhorted them to remain alert to meet emerging security challenges.

Shah Faesal shifted to detention centre at Centaur Hotel

Srinagar: Former IAS officer Shah Faesal, who is under detention, has been taken to a makeshift detention centre at the Centaur Hotel here, officials said on Thursday.

He was shifted from his home to the hotel during the night, they said. Faesal who was stopped from taking a flight to Istanbul at the Delhi airport during the intervening night of Tuesday and Wednesday was flown back to Srinagar where he was detained under the Public Safety Act (PSA), they said.

During preliminary questioning, Faesal said he was taking a connecting flight to London from Istanbul, the officials said. The former bureaucrat from Jammu & Kashmir had floated the Jammu & Kashmir Peoples Movement party after resigning from the IAS.

After being detained at the Delhi airport, he was again detained under the PSA on his arrival in Srinagar, the officials said. Faesal had criticised the "unprecedented" lock-down in the Valley with its eight million population "incarcerated" like never before post the removal of special status to Jammu & Kashmir, provided under Article 370. He is among the last political leaders who have been placed under house arrest.

Former Jammu & Kashmir Chief Ministers Farooq Abdullah, Omar Abdullah and Mehbooba Mufti were detained after the Centre revoked the special status and announced that the state be bifurcated into the territories of Jammu and Kashmir, and Ladakh. **PTI**

Ladakh celebrates '1st I-Day' after being declared UT

Ladakh, which will become a Union Territory after the bifurcation of Jammu & Kashmir, celebrated Independence Day with fervour on Thursday, with local BJP MP Jamyang Tsering Namgyal saying the region has got "independence from Kashmir".

The parliamentarian, whose speech in the Lok Sabha after abrogation of special status to Jammu & Kashmir drew praises, was seen dancing and playing the drums along with the locals.

Accompanied by BJP national general secretary Ram Madhav, Namgyal hoisted the national flag at the local party office.

On August 5, the Centre stripped Jammu & Kashmir of its special status given under Article 370 and split it into two Union territories, Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh, which will come into existence on October 31.

The region has got "independence from Kashmir" and the celebration is "just a trailer" for the development of Ladakh, Namgyal said.

Banners bearing slogans like "UT of Ladakh celebrates its 1st Independence Day" were

hanging along the roads of this picturesque town.

In a series of tweets, Namgyal said the tricolour in each and every house of Ladakh symbolises the patriotism of the people and their unwavering commitment towards India.

"Ladakh got independence from Kashmir," he said, adding that the spirit of patriotism is very high among school students and adults alike in the region. Cultural performances

by students were a delight of the celebrations and the entire atmosphere was filled with patriotic fervour and unity.

"So, we decided to celebrate Independence Day in the traditional Ladakhi style through the beating of the 'daman' and 'surma," he said, adding these celebrations are "just a trailer for the development of Ladakh".

Namgyal said, "On the occasion of Independence Day, we celebrate the martyrdom of

our heroes. We paid our respects to the four young heroes who laid down their lives agitating for the UT status for Ladakh". The four people died a few years ago.

The MP also shared on Twitter pictures of Buddhist monks hoisting national flag at his native village Matho, where people were celebrating "1st Independence Day after declaration of Ladakh as an Union Territory".
